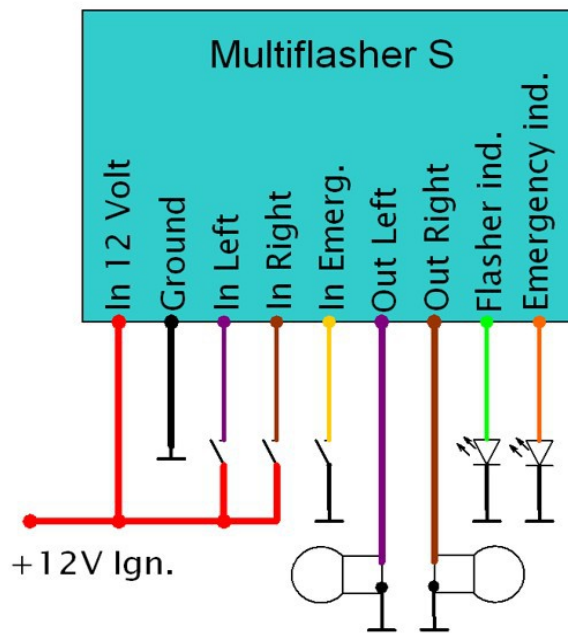


## Installation instruction Multi Flasher S

No time for manuals? No problem, this will only take a few minutes of your time to read it and the installation of your new Multi Flasher S is done fast and easy :-)



Color	Description
Violet (thin)	Input for the left flasher. Just connect it to your switch and wire the other side of the switch to plus 12 Volt ignition. A contact to plus 12 Volt will switch on the flashing function.
Brown (thin)	Input for the right flasher. Just connect it to your switch and wire the other cable from the switch to plus 12 Volt ignition.
Green	Output for the flasher indicator in the dashboard
Yellow	Input for emergency switch. The emergency flasher function is activated when this input is switched to ground
Orange	Output for emergency flasher indicator in the dashboard
Red (thick)	+ 12 Power
Violet (thick)	Output left flasher
Brown	Output right flasher
Black	Ground

### Note:

The outputs can control all kind of 12 Volt led flashers and "traditional" halogen bulbs up to 60 Watt per side. **Please note that the Multi Flasher S should be installed with a bit distance to the ignition system. If not, then it might result sometimes in "funny" unwanted functions of the Multi Flasher S due to electrostatic disturbances.**

The Multi Flasher Plus should be installed by professional well trained engineers. Please check your local regulations regarding the traffic light rules in your country before use the Multi Flasher S in your bike or car. Please be aware that we are not responsible for any hazards, damages or disadvantages due to the use of this device. We also declare that the Multi Flasher S is conform to the CE and ROHS regulations for the European market.
